Essays

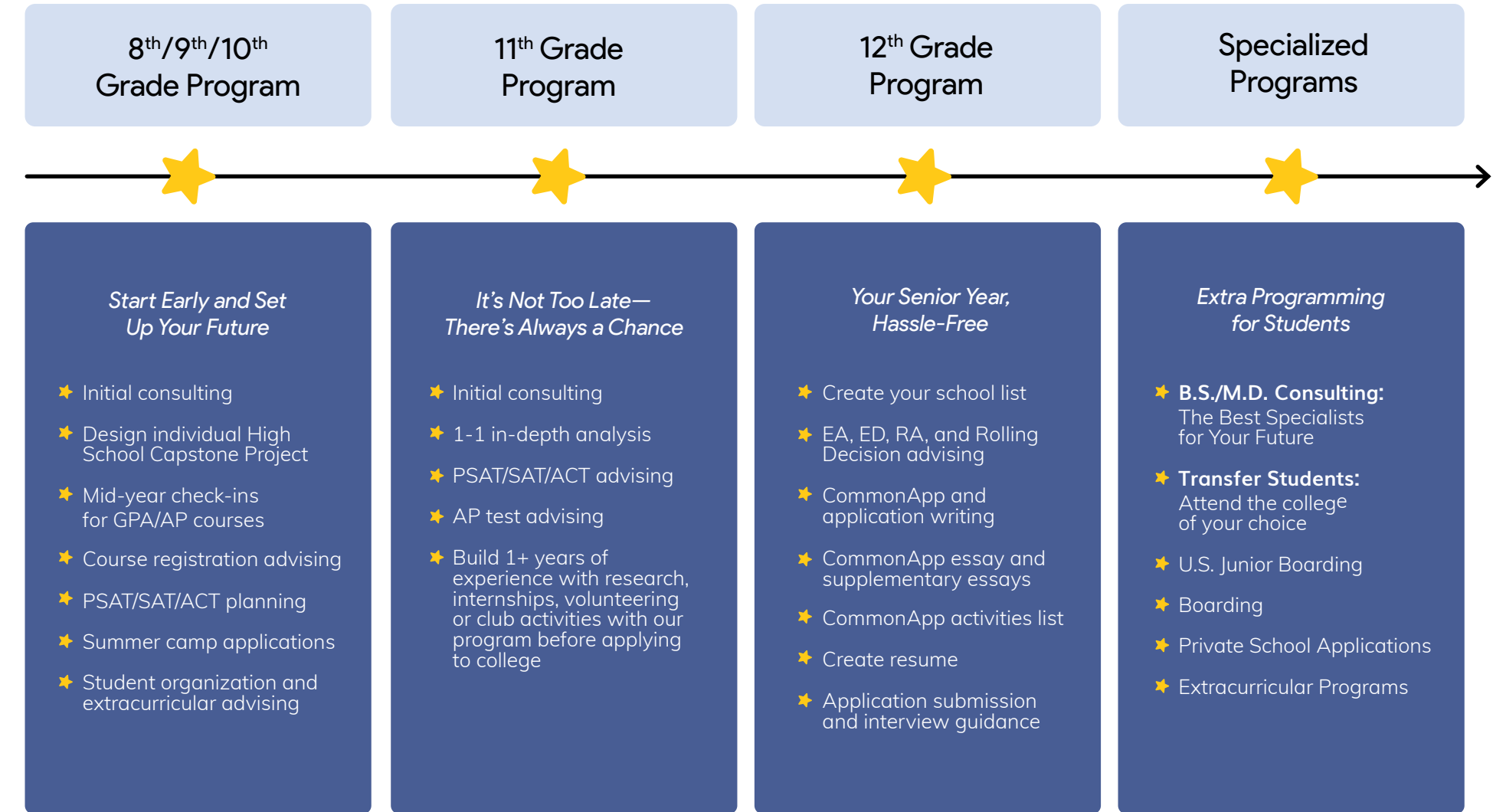
We provide thorough essay guidance in a 3-step process when writing a college admissions essay, as well as special guidance from an essay team recognized by Ivy Admissions Officers.



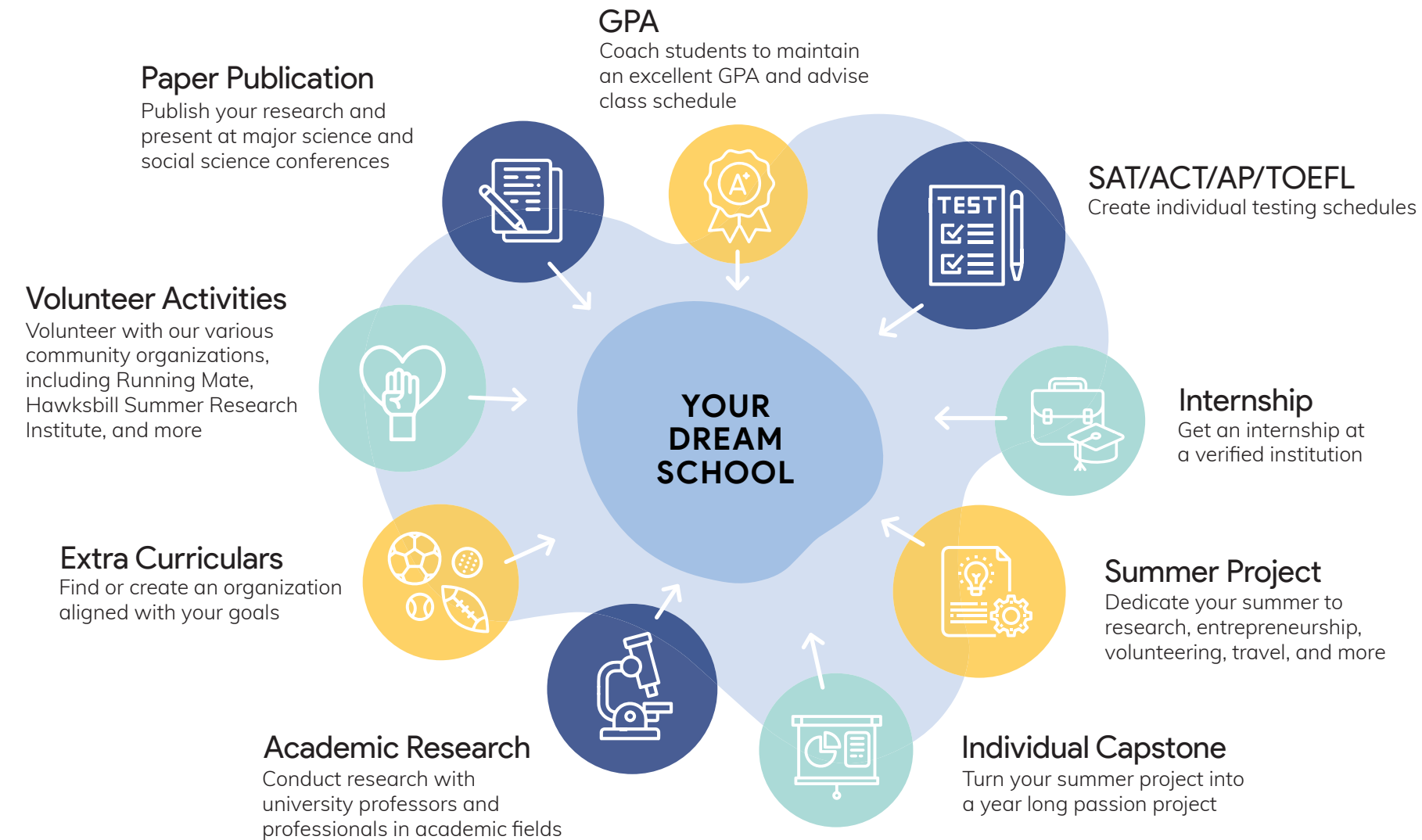
Specialists

We have a team of mentors made up of experts in different fields: scientists, doctors, lawyers, university professors, high school teachers, and counselors.

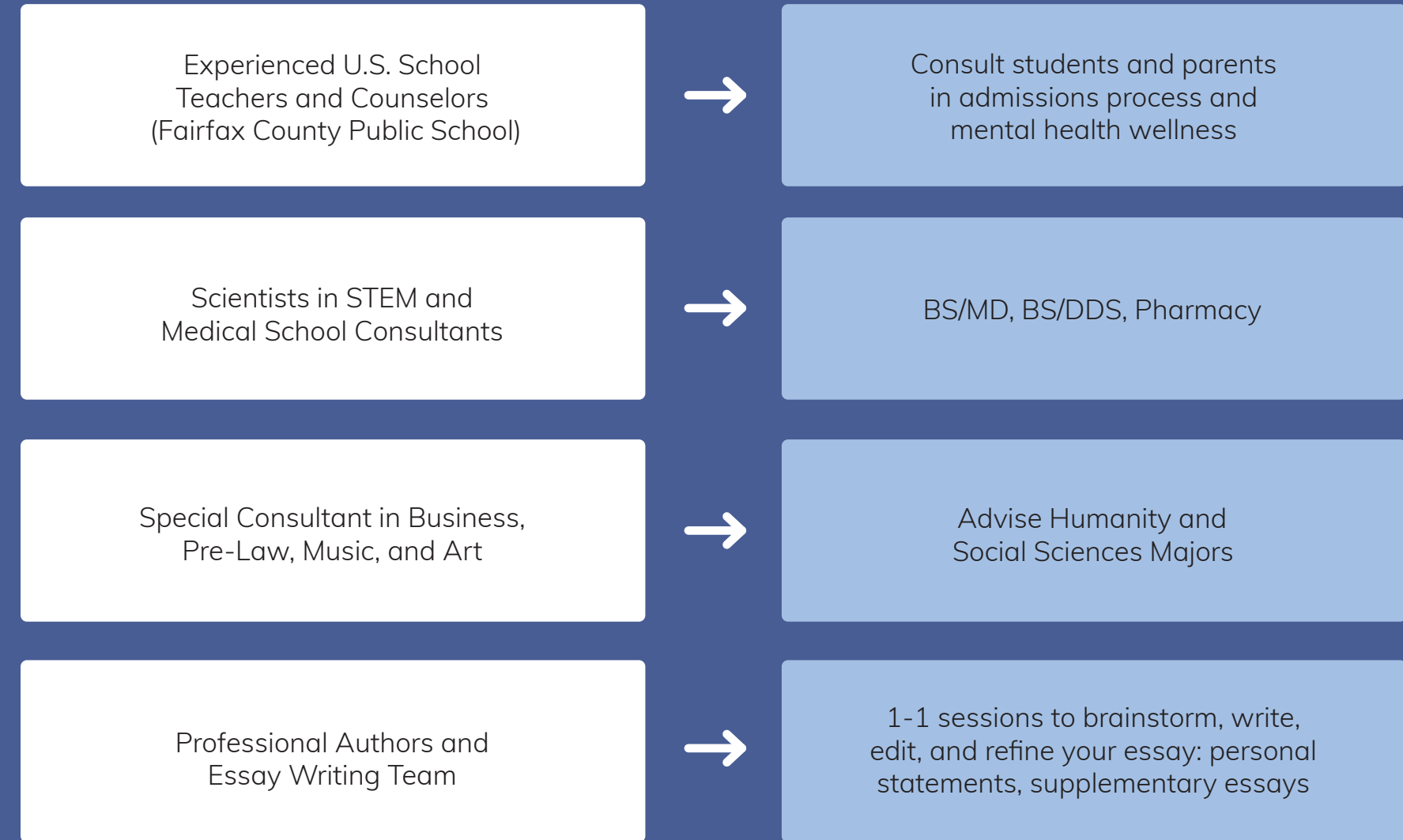

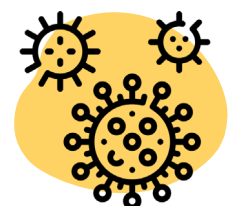

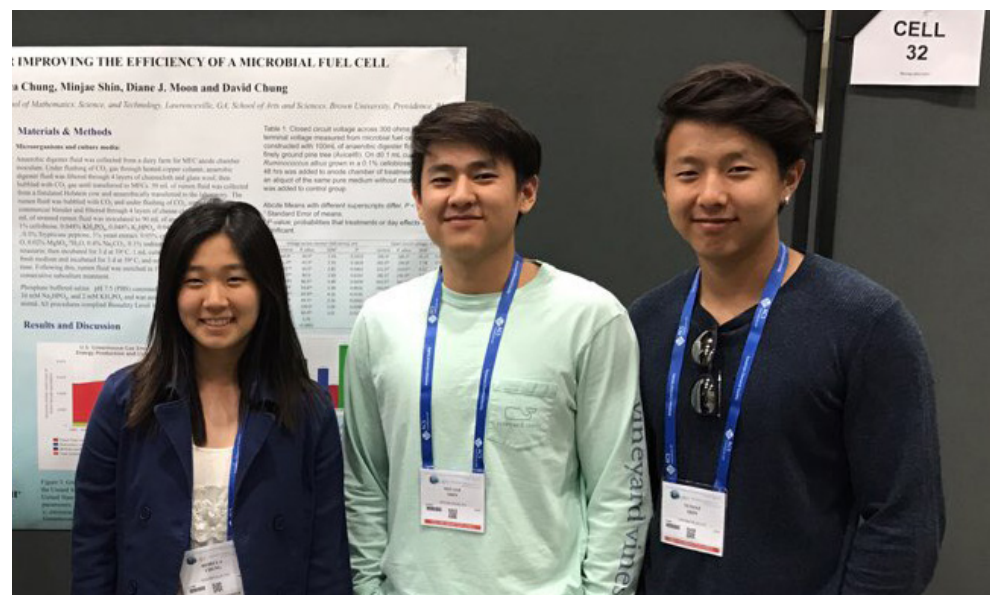

The Belize Marine Biology Program conducts research on the endangered Great Moor Sea Turtle (Hawksbill) in Belize, located in the southern part of the Yucatan Peninsula in Central America. It observes various endangered creatures on the land and in the ocean and studies its ecology.

This project is conducted annually by biology professor Dr. Rimkus and his research team. After completing our research program, participants participate in international conferences and present their research results.
